3. Headshot (300 dpi)
4. One to three proposals (100 words each, max)
5. Time slots can be anywhere from 30 minutes to 90 minutes. Please specify how much time you need for each proposal.
6. Room setup and/or what students should bring for training (i.e., Escrima, knives, stretch bands, etc.)
7. **Deadline to submit application:** Wednesday, Jan. 31, 2024.
